A certificate of recognition for Byron-Bethany Irrigation District's success in defending agricultural water rights was recently presented to the district by Rep. Jeff Denham, R-Turlock.

Denham congratulated the district on winning a lawsuit against the state water board for filing charges against the district for what the water board charged was unauthorized diversion of drought-restricted water from the Delta. A Santa Clara County Superior Court judge found that the district's due-process rights were violated and ruled for the district.

The decision has a statewide impact in water-rights litigation.
