RE: 6/15/2021 BOARD MEETING – ITEM 5: Consideration of a proposed Resolution to adopt Emergency Regulations to address water shortages in the Russian River Watershed

Dear Ms. Townsend,

Byron-Bethany Irrigation District (BBID) appreciates the opportunity to submit comments on the above-referenced agenda items.

Among other defects, the revised methodology does not utilize the best available data. Instead of using current data, the methodology estimates water availability during 2021 using demand data from 2018 and 2019. This is not the best available data. Permittees and licensees submitted 2020 reports. Thus, the analysis should be updated with 2020 data for permittees and licensees. In addition, many large diverters measure diversions in real time, including major reservoir operators. Thus, when available, the analysis should be updated with real-time diversion information. While the available real-time data are provisional, contemporaneous data are more accurate than data from a different year.

We also request that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) acknowledge that other watersheds may have different characteristics, and the quantity and quality of available data may differ between watersheds. In addition, stakeholders in other watersheds may not have had the opportunity to review and comment upon the application of the proposed methodology in the Russian River Watershed. For these reasons, we request that the State Water Board clarify that the methodology proposed for the Russian River Watershed will not be precedential for other watersheds within the state.
