DESCRIPTION:

Annual Salary Range from \$52,860 to \$104,306

Under direction from supervisor to perform physical work and operate a variety of handheld, power, and heavy vehicle equipment in the construction, maintenance, and repair of District facilities.

This is a non-exempt series and is part of the Operations and Maintenance Department.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

Duties may include, but are not limited to the following:

- Operates a variety of tools and equipment including but not limited to, dump trucks, crawler tractors below Case 1450 type, rubber tire tractors, flatbed trucks, boom trucks electric, hydraulic, or pneumatic hand tools and motorized equipment.
- Construct forms for concrete structures.
- Construct, maintain and repair irrigation pipelines, canals, or electric conduit/duct systems.
- Rebuild, install, and maintain canal control gates and Install pre-cast pipe.
- Shore trenches.
- Install, service and repair pumps and pump facilities and know and perform safety checks on equipment.
- Observe safety regulations and maintain a safe work. environment.
- Install and maintain landscape.
- Mix and apply pesticides according to label, and governing regulations.
- Perform general carpentry, operate gunite and related equipment.
- Routine use of welding and cutting torch.
- Check and document water usage by irrigators.
- Perform overtime emergency work.

Other Related Duties

Performs other duties as assigned.

TYPICAL QUALIFICATIONS:

Construction Maintenance Worker I

Any combination of education, experience, knowledge, and abilities may satisfy the necessary minimum qualifications. A typical way to obtain the education, experience, knowledge, and abilities would be:

Education: High School diploma or equivalent.

Experience: Three (3) years' experience in general construction, agricultural operations, equipment operation, and general maintenance work.

Construction Maintenance Worker II

Two (2) years' experience performing work as a Construction Maintenance Worker I with BBID, or equivalent experience.

Construction Maintenance Worker III

Three (3) years' experience performing work as a Construction Maintenance Worker II with BBID, or equivalent experience.

Knowledge and Abilities:

- Knowledge of construction techniques; construction hand tools, carpentry, and concrete forming practices.
- Landscaping and weed control work.
- Ability to operate a variety of construction equipment and small hand tools.
- Work in confined spaces.
- Perform light to heavy physical labor in various weather and work site conditions.
- Understand and carry-out oral and written directions.
- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with staff and the public.

Special Requirements:

Must have a valid California Class C driver license. Obtain an appropriate Class A driver license with air brake, tanker, and combo endorsements, during the first ten (10) months as a Construction/Maintenance Worker and maintain thereafter. Employee may be required to obtain Cal EPA *Qualified Application License* and *Crane Certification* subject to management discretion and must be maintained thereafter. This position may require any or all of the following: night shift, weekend, holiday, on-call, and overtime work. The work schedule during the irrigation season shall consist of seven (7) consecutive days.
