The Byron Bethany Irrigation District (BBID) is a multi-county public agency special district serving parts of Alameda, Contra Costa, and San Joaquin Counties across 55 square miles and 36,000 acres. BBID is governed by a seven-member elected Board of Directors headquartered in Byron, California. With a full-time equivalent (FTE) staff of 26 positions, the district serves more than 215 agricultural customers and provides wholesale water to more than 50,000 residents in Mountain House and Tracy Hills.

The BBID is seeking initiative-taking individuals to join its construction and facilities maintenance team in maintaining, repairing, and upgrading its canal and ditch agricultural irrigation water system. Under supervision, this entry-level job classification may perform the following duties:

- Operates a variety of tools and equipment including but not limited to, dump trucks, tractors, flatbed trucks, boom trucks, electric, hydraulic, or pneumatic hand tools, and motorized equipment.
- Constructs and maintains structures, facilities and building related components.
- Constructs and removes forms for concrete structures, and pours and finishes concrete.
- Constructs, maintains and repairs irrigation pipelines, canals, or conduit/duct systems.
- Constructs concrete structures for placing gates, builds headwalls, weirs, flumes and other facilities required for operation of the water delivery system.
- Rebuilds, installs, and maintains canal control gates and installs pre-cast pipe.
- Performs general carpentry, operates gunite and related equipment.
- Conducts aquatic plant control from canals.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

The starting wage for this entry-level position is \$33.01 per hour with the ability for career advancement based on satisfactory job performance, experience, certifications, training, and skills development. BBID also offers an excellent benefit package including participation in the California Public Employees Retirement System (CalPERS); available medical, dental, and vision insurance; and paid vacation, sick, and holiday leave. Candidates who exceed

the qualifications for this entry-level position or who have significant related experience may be considered for placement at a higher classification within the Construction Maintenance Worker series.
